Plan and Projects

Asia Pacific Gateway (APG) Project

APG project is a cooperation between CAT and international telecommunication agencies to construct a 10-pair international submarine cable network which can provide 137×40 Gbps per pair. The landing stations of the project are in Thailand, Japan, South Korea, China, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Vietnam, Malaysia and Singapore The project improves Thailand's intra-ASEAN communication competency and facilitate the forthcoming ASEAN Economic Community (AEC). This project has started in 2012 and is expected to be in-service in 2016.

Digital Trunked Radio System (DTRS) Development

Trunked Mobile is a specific group wireless communication. The project constructed digital Trunked Mobile network to replace the existing analogue one and expand coverage area. Regarding to competition and market condition, the expansion aims to cover more business and industrial districts to serve customer needs with modernized service. This service has been launched at the end of 2015.
